

Art

The children will study the work of Aboriginal/ Indigenous Art of Australia. They will experiment with colours and symbols. They will create their own piece of Aboriginal Art and then we hope to use this to make an instrument out of tubs and/or tubes.

Music

This term in Music we will be learning about; pitch, pulse, rhythm and tempo. We will also listen to some traditional Australian music.

History/Geography

As we are looking at Australia for our theme this term our history focus will be the amazing accomplishments of Amy Johnson.

In geography we will be looking at the continents and oceans as well as making comparisons between the UK and Australia.

RE

In addition to exploring the Easter Story this term we will also be exploring different creation stories and thinking about how we can all care for our world.

English & Maths

We will be following the White Rose Scheme to develop our knowledge and understanding of addition, subtraction, multiplication & division. The children will continue to develop their arithmetic methods, fluency knowledge and skills of problems solving and reasoning. English lessons will focus on specific genres of writing e.g. Instructions, Non-Fiction reports and recounts. Our topic story will be The Diary of a Wombat by Jackie French.

Design**Technology**

The children will have opportunity to explore model aeroplanes and then make their own model aeroplane. They will think about how to join the materials together and how to make their aeroplane functional and appealing to their chosen audience.

PE

Tigers Trust will deliver our PE sessions.

Computing

This term we will learn computer skills such as; using a mouse, saving and reopening work and recording videos.

Science

As scientists, the children will be learning about living things (animals, plants and humans). They will learn how to group living things according to their habitat, diet and type (e.g. mammal, reptile, amphibian, fish, bird, or insect).
