LAYERS OF THE EARTH

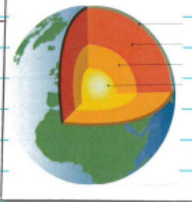
A volcano Has:

a crater
ash cloud
main vent
lava flow
magma chamber
layers of lava and ash
secondary vent
conduit

The layers of the earth are the:

Outer core
crust
inner core
mantle

(Lava is Magma whilst it is in the inner core)



Two of the worlds worst volcanoes are Mount Vesuvius and Mount St Helens. Mount Vesuvius last erupted in 1980 ruining the Roman city of Pompeii it is know Dormant Mount St Helens last erupted in 1980 and is also know Dormant.

Extinct, Dormant, Active

Volcanoes can be:

Extinct - A volcano which is not likely to erupt again.

Dormant - A volcano which has not erupted for a long time but may erupt again.

Active - A volcano which is erupting or has recently erupted.

Introduction

Volcanoes are a world phenomenon

Volcanoes are large mounds of rock sometimes even Mountains. About 90% of the worlds volcanoes are located in a place known as the ring of fire. Although Volcanoes are connected to the earths inner core they sit on the earths crust.

Types of Volcanoes

There are three different forms of Volcano: Composite Volcanoes, shield volcanoes and cinder cone volcanoes. Composite Volcanoes are steep sided, shield volcanoes are named for their shield like shape and cinder cone volcanoes are formed when lava fragments are blown from the vent and fall.



The ring of fire

The ring of fire is where 90% of the worlds active volcanoes are. It not only has volcanoes on land, the ring of fire also has underwater volcanoes. One of which has just erupted and created Tsunami waves which have recently destroyed the main island of Tonga.

GLOSSARY

Ash cloud - A large cloud of smoke and Debris.
Lava flows - magma that escapes from the inside of a volcano.
Lahars - when volcanic matters mix with snow or water.

- More than 80% of the earths surface is volcanic in origin.
- Volcanoes can grow quickly.
- There are 20 volcanoes erupting right now.
- There are more than 500 active volcanoes in the world.
- The danger area of a volcano is 20 miles.
- When a volcano erupt the only noise it might make could be a hissing sound.
- The most deadly eruptions have occurred in Indonesia.
