Our value this half-term is Justice.

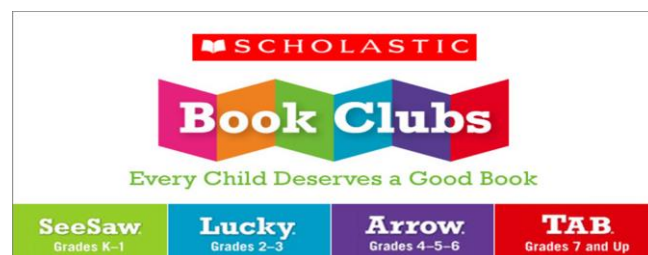


We will explore with the children the idea of being fair and respecting other people's rights.
