



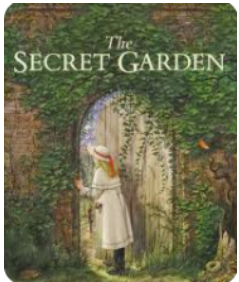

#### Key book this term



English

This term we will continue to build on our incredible literacy skills by looking at the book, 'The Secret Garden'. This book will support in developing our understanding of characterisation and adapting for film narratives. This book provides us with an insight into life in Yorkshire at the beginning of the 20th Century and therefore links to our 'Local History' topic whilst adding a high quality to our literacy work!

Science - 'Animals including Humans' and 'Plants'.

In the first part of the term, we will be continuing our work on animals including humans. This will include investigating nutrition and how to have a healthy diet. We will also be exploring the muscles and bones in the body.

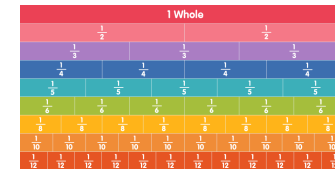
In the second part of the term, we will be exploring plants. We will be looking at the parts of a plant and exploring the job that part of the flower has.



RE - Our world- who cares?

This term, we will be looking at varying beliefs about how the world was created and how religion encourages people to look after the world we live in. We will explore big questions about whose job it is to take care of the world and what we can do to help.

#### Maths

This term we are continuing to work on our rapid recall of multiplication facts. The Year 4 pupils will be completing their MTC text later on this term.

We will continue to follow the Maths NCETM program to develop our knowledge and understanding of different mathematical concepts. The children will develop their fluency knowledge, skills of problem solving and reasoning, using different techniques including the use of practical resources.

## Humanities - Local History

During this topic about 'Local History' we will be exploring past and present maps of of local area and learning how Yorkshire was used in the past. We will explore how Hull has changed over time. We will also look at how to use maps effectively and the 8 points of a compass.



## French

We will build on previous knowledge to include singing nursery rhymes to support our understanding of the French language.

We will continue to have PE on a Monday afternoon and Friday morning.

Music is also on a Friday morning with Mrs Hunt.



## Art

Children will be exploring the work of Joan Miro while experimenting with surrealism techniques. We will also be looking at Michelle Reader and her use of recycling for sculpting linking to our RE topic of 'Our World-Who Cares?'



## DT

This term, the children will be using their knowledge of healthy eating in Science to create a savoury dish and evaluate their learning.



## PSHE

The children will be continuing to develop their understanding of necessities in life. They will be looking at the difference between an want and a need. They will be discussing how decisions are made and the impact decisions have on others.
